As the Nebraska Society of Medical Assistants Conference Chairs, it is our privilege and pleasure to extend this official invitation to you to attend the 55th Annual NSMA Conference April 30th & May 1st, 2021 at Ramada by Wyndham Midtown hotel at 2503 S Locust St, Grand Island, NE 68801. Included is the registration form. As you will notice on the registration form, you have the option of the full two-day registration, which is your best deal or individual days if you are not able to come for the entire conference. Registration will begin Friday at 8 AM. There will be 11 hours of continuing education presented with the full two-day registration. The applicable fees are included in the registration fee. Registration deadline is April 10, 2021, no refunds after April 17, 2021.

The hotel includes free continental breakfast buffet, high-speed internet, indoor pool, free parking and a restaurant.
